ROBERT A CUNNINGHAM MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Robert A Cunningham was a dedicated volunteer at General Electric Credit Union for over 30 years. His spirit of volunteerism was seen in his love of youth sports and his commitment to scholastic achievement and college education. This scholarship was created to recognize college-bound high school seniors who embody the spirit of volunteerism like the late Mr. Cunningham.

Five Scholarships will be awarded and each scholarship recipient will receive a one-time award for \$2,000

The applicant must:

- Be a college-bound, graduating high school senior
- Have a strong academic record with at least a "B" average
- Be a primary member of GECU; have an account in their name (students may join if they qualify for membership)
- Have participated in activities demonstrating the spirit of volunteerism

Applications must also include:

- An essay (see Scholarship application for details)
- Two letters of recommendation (one from an organization for which the applicant volunteers)
- An official copy of his or her high school transcript



Applications are due January 12, 2021 and paper copies can be found in the Counseling Center.



DOES YOUR STUDENT HAVE A NOVEMBER 1ST COLLEGE APPLICATION DEADLINE?

If your student has a November 1st deadline for their college applications, the counselors need transcript requests by October 19th. This gives to counselors and students time to fix any materials if needed, awareness of written evaluations, and if documents need to be physically mailed they will arrive to their destination on time.

OCTOBER CAREER CLUSTER: HEALTH SCIENCE

In the Health Science cluster you would promote health and wellness or diagnose and treat injuries and disease. You could work directly with people or you could work in laboratories to get information used in research or diagnosis. Health service employees go to work at a variety of different sites. Some work in hospitals, offices, or laboratories. Others work on cruise ships, at sports arenas, or within communities.

The outlook for employment in the Health Science cluster is very good. The number of elderly people is growing and they have greater health care needs. Advances in medical technology have increased the number of people who survive serious illnesses and injuries. These patients need more intensive therapy and care. The jobs in hospitals will grow the slowest. This is the result of an increase in outpatient care and services.

Some pathways students can follow are Therapeutic services, diagnostic services, health information, support services, and biotechnology research and development. <u>Click here</u> for more information!

PSAT AT MERCY MCAULEY

- The PSAT = Preliminary SAT
- Students should be in assigned classrooms by 8:00 am and will be dismissed at approximately 12 Noon.
- Virtual students will need to come to school to take this test.
 There will be no make-up test unless student tested positive for Covid or is required to quarantine on this date.
- For most, it is a practice test in a standardized setting that provides helpful insight on college entrance testing strengths as well as areas that could benefit from further preparation.
- Students will receive a very detailed score report after completion.
- The PSAT is also a qualifying test for the National Merit Scholarship Program (juniors only).
- Students all across the country will be taking the PSAT on 10/14/2020.
- Students should get a good night's sleep and eat a hearty breakfast before testing.
- Students should bring 2, #2 pencils with erasers and an approved calculator.
- Seniors do not take the PSAT and do not have school on 10/14/2020. They are encouraged to work on college applications or go on a college campus visit.
- Freshmen DO have school and will have their retreat day.




